Seventh Sunday of Easter (C)

Laudato Si'

Ten years ago this last week the late Pope Francis wrote one of his most important encyclicals, known by its title (in medieval Italian, not Latin), *Laudato Si'*, 'On Care for our Common Home.' This was the first papal encyclical letter in history to be devoted entirely to care for creation and the environment. I was asked to write a brief 'blog' piece explaining the letter by the Catholic paper the *Catholic Herald* (I think it's been now deleted from their website) to which I received many very angry responses, particularly from the US (people disliked the Holy Father more than they disliked me). What were these people's problems?

The pope's letter was a 'wake-up call' to the whole world; and also to the Church, where many didn't take the issue of how we care for the world seriously. He went out of his way to remind readers that what he was writing is part of the Church's ordinary moral teaching, which Catholics are obliged to follow. You can't be a good Catholic and a climate

change denier. Many Catholics, particularly in the US, still oppose this and we see some of the results now. Easy to read the letter at https://www.vatican.va/ content/francesco/en/encyclicals/documents/papa-
