Third Sunday of Advent (A) - *Gaudete Sunday*

Rejoice!

One of the mainstays in most parishes is people's real and tangible generosity in terms of giving to the Church. So in recent weeks we have had a donation towards the costs of our new heating system, a donation to cover the cost of a new organ (which will be installed next week) and, this weekend, brand new rose pink vestments made in Sri Lanka. We are very grateful to these donors for their generosity. We only wear pink twice a year: on this third Sunday of Advent, known as *Gaudete* ('Rejoice!') Sunday and the Fourth Sunday of Lent (*Laetare* Sunday), a day to lift slightly Advent austerity and restraint. Joyfulness in hope for the coming of God's kingdom is a theme of Advent; this isn't a superficial jollity (we see enough of that), but grounded in teachings about our faith which we encounter so strongly in the beautiful Scripture readings we hear at Mass. This gives us strength and confidence to resist phoney expressions of religious faith (such as the Carol Concert in London being organised by *Unite the Kingdom*) and so many other false messages in the world. The seasons of Advent and Christmas should not lead us to be naïve or blind to the existence of evil and sin in the world. People who hate do not experience real joy.

This newsletter - an appeal

In any parish a weekly newsletter is an important way for people to learn about Christian teaching and keep in touch with what is going on in the church and also an advertisement to others about our life. Since I came here I have been indebted to Joe Haig who has laid out impressively the material I have gathered, in addition to his other commitments (not least conducting the choir at the 10am Mass); but we need now to find new people to take on Joe's role and most of what I have had to do as well. For this reason we want a **Newsletter** team to be *responsible* for producing it this week. We need a team to do these things:

- To type out the basic text – this requires an ability to use desktop publishing software, such as Scribus or Microsoft Publisher
- To edit the contents – that is collect and put together the contributions, such as the list of intentions, anniversaries and events notified. This will include a contribution from me as parish priest but I shouldn't be the editor
- To photocopy 180 copies each week. We are about to acquire a new copier (which will be able to print in colour) which will be in the developing parish office/outer sacristy. The one we have been using for some years has made this one of the most demanding aspects of all this, particularly for me as I only have to look at a copier for paper to jam.

Joe and I can give guidance about how all this is done – as you can see, it needs more than two people! Since we're engaged in trying to widen participation in parish life, we really need people to do this *who don't have other responsibilities in the parish*. Advent is a time for new beginnings – please think about the gifts you might have to offer to the parish. Many hands make light work. I am very grateful to Joe for all he has done.
